- Home visitation, Hamilton County Public Health, Wright County Health Department, and Humboldt County Public Health
- Child Care Advisor (kits for social and emotional support in infants and toddlers.



- Early Childhood Education Consultant (PBIS for centers and preschools, Gold Assessments, Gold Training, Early Learning Standards Training)
- Preschool Scholarships for three and four year olds residing at 200% FPL
- Parent Connection, Parent development, Ages and Stages Assessment, and assistance to families locating resources.

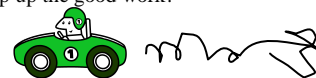
